Your Excellency,

I write about the arrests of Sergio EDWARD MARTINEZ, Francisco MORADA PEREZ, Patricio GOMEZ and twelve others. I am informed by Amnesty International that the above persons were arrested in Curico on the 2nd November 1980. At present I am also informed that the cause of their arrest is unknown as are the circumstances of their detention.

I humbly remind you that their arrest and detention would appear to contravene Article 9 of the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights which states: "No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile". In addition their arrest and detention appears to contravene the United Nations International Convention on Civil and Political Rights which was ratified by Chile on 10th February 1972.

I respectfully request verification of their legal situation; if no charges are brought against them I urge that they be immediately released.
